

My approach as a psychological astrologer

Astrology links what happens in the individual and collective lives of human beings to the movement of the planets through the solar system of which we are part. It is an art/science charged with power: the power to help us find our place, tiny but unique, in the interconnected world in which we all live, move and have our being.

This can be done through the medium of a carefully calculated birth horoscope, and a conversation: between client, astrologer, and the planets which paint a vivid symbolic picture of the characters on Life's stage through their placements in the signs and houses of the birth chart. Helping clients in getting to know those characters, thus enabling them to live their lives with as much awareness, acceptance and understanding both of self and others as possible, has always been my aim as a psychological astrologer. These days, it informs the way I work with both colleagues and students seeking mentoring support.

In addition to obtaining my Certificate from the Faculty of Astrological Studies in 1983, throughout the 1990s I broadened and deepened my knowledge by commuting by air monthly from my home base in Glasgow to London, where I was fortunate to study with world-renowned astrologers Dr Liz Greene and the late Charles Harvey at the Centre for Psychological Astrology in London, obtaining their Diploma in 1998.

I have continued to consult, teach and write since then, only deciding from July 2019 to give up doing readings – to concentrate more fully on mentoring, teaching and writing.
